

Conflict minerals from Democratic Replublic of Congo and adjoining Countries; Dodd Frank Act 1502

Dear valued customer.

In July 2010, the U.S. Government signed the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act (the "Dodd-Frank Act"). The Conflict Minerals provision of Dodd-Frank Act 1502 places new burden on SEC registered corporations to trace and report the source of Conflict Minerals (tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold) in their products.

Conflict Minerals means minerals that are sourced from DRC (Democratic Republic of Congo) and its adjoining countries e.g. Burundi, Rwanda & Uganda etc.

The mining of those conflict minerals finance or benefit directly or indirectly armed groups in the DRC and adjoining countries.
